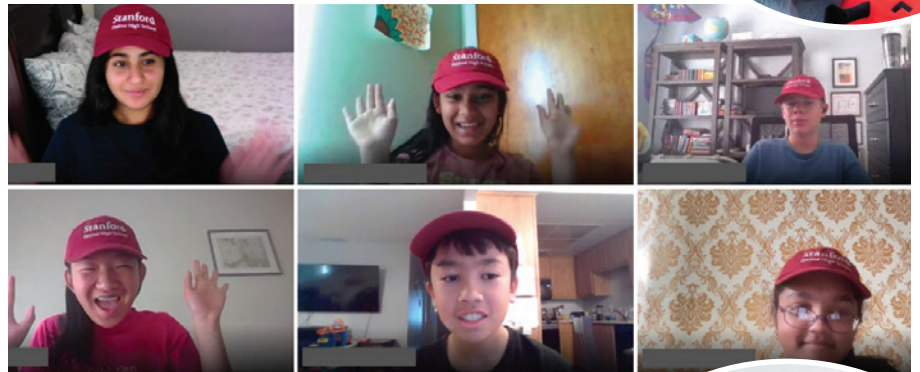

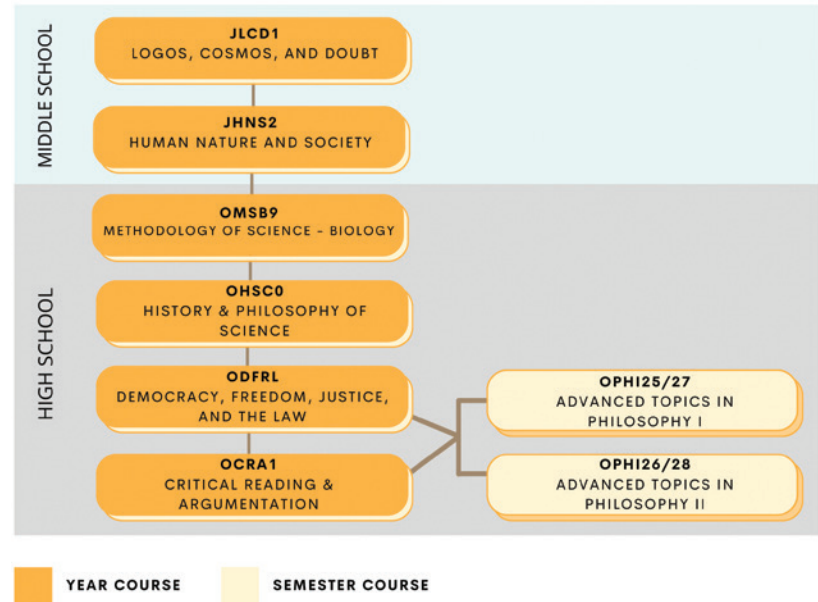

The Core Sequence

The Core Sequence is unique to the academic curriculum at Stanford OHS. Courses are interdisciplinary, with topics including human nature, science, political theory, and philosophy. In discussions, students examine assertions from a variety of sources, and develop evidence-based argumentation and critical thinking skills. Core courses, required for high school students on a graduation path, are focused on the sciences and humanities alike. Students develop analytical writing and presentation skills with rigorous written assignments and discourse. The expertise and skills cultivated in the Core curriculum prepare students for further intellectual growth and citizenship in high school, university, and beyond.

Required Application Materials

- Academic records: transcripts from this year and the past two years (2022-23, 2023-24, Fall 2024)
- Two application essays, each 400 words maximum
- One sample of analytical writing from a school assignment
- Two recommendation forms submitted by current or prior year teachers
